Come with your questions, come with your awe!
**For the God who broods over the chaos
meets us in this place.**

Come with your energy, come with your weariness!
**For the God who breathes new life into the dust
meets us in this place.**

Come with your sadness, come with your joy!
**For the God who dared to become human
meets us in this place.**

The tune of the **opening voluntary** is a theme from *The Planets* by English composer Gustav Holst (1874-1934.)

A greeting in the name of Jesus Christ establishes the context for worship as an encounter with the Holy One who calls all things into being.

When he was pastor of a Presbyterian church in Lockport, NY, the author of this **hymn** text referred to his morning walks as “going out into my Father’s world.” The tune created for these words is based on an English melody the composer, F. L. Shepherd, learned from his mother when he was a boy.

The ritual of confession and assurance is not a time of judgment; it is a time of grace. It is not a time to fear God; it is a time to experience God's unending love through Jesus. It is a time to take a load off our shoulders so that we might more freely live.
