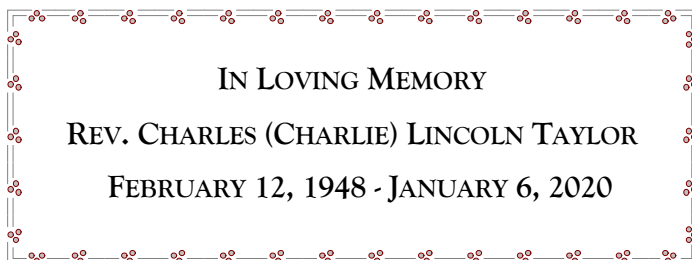
FAITH FORMATION

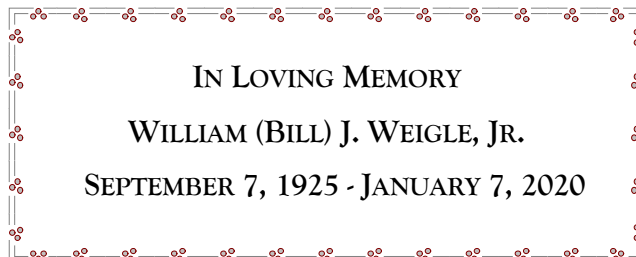
